Trims/Findings in children's products must meet CPSIA requirements Zippers Aluminum zippers are not allowed				
<ul> <li>Zipper slides must be locking - either auto-lock, pin-lock, or semi-automatic lock</li> <li><i>Children's Products:</i></li> <li>If using 3-part zipper, it must meet 'pull tab twist test'</li> </ul>				
<ul> <li>Must include zipper guard over the slider and pull when closed</li> <li>Zipper stops must be in place at both ends of the zipper to prevent the slider from pulling off the tape. Stops can be metal clips, machine stitched bartacks, or hand stitched wrapping of the teeth</li> </ul>				
<ul> <li>Fasteners (buttons, grippers, snaps, eyelets, grommets)</li> <li>Must be secured through two layers of fabric. Fasteners on a single ply fabric must be supported with non-woven/non-fusible discs - with approval only</li> <li>Metal components must be plated, lacquered, or enamaled to be corrosion resistant. Trims/Findings in children's products must meet CPSIA requirements		
<ul> <li>Bead/Sequin</li> <li>Refer to <u>'Bead &amp; Sequin Attachment Guide' on K-link</u></li> <li>Suitable stabilizer must be used with lightweight fabrics</li> <li>Thread must be knotted off sufficiently throughout to prevent excessive beads/ sequins from falling off</li> </ul>		
<ul> <li>Piping</li> <li>Pre-shrunk cotton cord - smooth not braided. May be foam filling</li> <li>Must not twist or kink inside piping covering</li> <li>Maximum finished filed piping diameter - 6.35mm or 1/4"</li> </ul>	Piping Cover must be bias cut unless otherwise specified	Piping Cover may be straight cut for straight edges but must be bias cut for curved/shaped edges

<ul> <li>Flat Sheet</li> <li>Top hem design treatment/construction as specified. Should follow low duty classification construction</li> <li>Sides are hemmed last</li> </ul>	Open ends of top hem are stitched closed with lockstitch	
<ul> <li>Fitted Sheet</li> <li>Corner pocket seam type as specified by brand</li> <li>Elastic is applied to entire bottom hem circumference</li> <li>Elastic stretch ratio: 1:2.5 minimum</li> <li><i>For Woven Sheets</i></li> <li>Woven elastic type as specified. Must source the specified elastic model # from the assigned supplier only</li> <li>Minimum 1" flat overlap reinforcement at elastic start/stop by vertically stitching elastic ends together using SN LS TS with backstitch</li> <li><i>For Knit Sheets</i></li> <li>Knit elastic as specified with firm power and excellent recovery</li> <li>Elastic is applied flat with 5-thread safety stitch, knife removed</li> <li>Elastic hem is closed at corner pocket seam</li> <li>Elastic is reinforced at seam by turning seam allowance to one side and SN LS TS both ends together in the hem.</li> </ul>	<b>Corner pocket:</b> Clean finished double turned, single needle lockstitch (ISO 301), reinforced	<b>Corner pocket:</b> Sewn 5-thread safety stitch (ISO 516), mock safety (ISO 512) or 4-thread overedge (ISO 514) for knits, with or without SN or 2N topstitch
