HOW TO SEARCH IN A PDF

PDF allows you to search by key words.

- 1. Open PDF file.
- 2. Click Ctrl + F.
- 3. The Find window will open. Type ahead a key word to search. EXAMPLE: Fit Eval
- 4. Hit Enter on keyboard or click next. Everytime you hit enter or click next, the document will jump to the next time "fit eval" or key word is mentioned.


Note: PDF does not recognize key words in screen shots and images. PDF will only locate key words within keyed text.



HOW TO USE BOOKMARKS IN A PDF

PDF allows you to navigate using bookmarks.

- 1. Open PDF file.
- 2. Click the bookmark symbol. The bookmarks will expand.
- 3. Scroll to find the title of the page and click on it.
