

DESIGN INTENT

VERSIONS

1. If **REPLACE IMAGE** was used, OnePLM saves the old image. This is helpful to go back to old files that were recently replaced.
2. Click **VER**. The file upload window will appear showing previously saved files.
3. Click **Make Current** to choose the option to be visible.
