RECYCLED WOVENLABELS

The Zabin Group has partnered with several recycled yarn suppliers to provide certified recycled woven labels. Utilizing continuous polyester yarn produced from post-consumer recycled polymer is environmentally friendly and provides a nearly identical look and feel of the traditional virgin polyester label. Recycling **1,000 kg** of PET eliminates the production of up to **3,000 kg** of greenhouse gasses, which averages the total emissions of an automobile in a single year.

CERTIFIED**RECYCLED** CONTENTSTOCKS

Our team can help provide a wide range of post-consumer waster (PCW) papers that can be utilized in exciting packaging programs. By using PCW papers, and contributing our excess paper waste to recycling companies, we are assured that a major percentage of our products and paper waste will potentially **never be sent to a landfill site.** Recycled content options range between **10 – 100%** of the finished paper stock.





ORGANIC**COTTONLABELS**

Organic cotton is produced and certified to organic agricultural standards. The production systems replenish and maintain soil fertility, reduce the use of toxic and persistent pesticides and fertilizers, and builds biologically diverse agriculture. Organic cotton uses **71% less water** and **62% less energy** than conventional cotton. Conventional cotton uses about 16% of the world's insecticide and 7% of the world's pesticide. Reducing the amount of dangerous and unhealthy toxins is critical as these chemicals eventually find there way into our food supply chain. While the initial costs of seed and soil preparation, harvesting, whitening, and dyeing may be more expensive, the long-term advantages are priceless.



The Zabin group has a vast network of certified raw material partners. This allows us to provide our customers with a variety of sustainable material options, for labels, tags, and other specialty trim items.

RECYCLED**COTTON**



Organic cotton is softer, more breathable and higher quality than non-organic cotton. It is grown **GMO-free** without the use of chlorine bleach, synthetic dyes or any synthetic agricultural chemicals.



BAMBOO

Bamboo is hypoallergenic, absorbent, fast drying and naturally anti-bacterial, while both extremely durable and soft as silk at half the price. It grows quickly at 10 times the yield of cotton with **less** input of water **pesticides** and **fertilizers**.

RECYCLED**POLYESTER**

Recycled polyester offers excellent quality for **less energy** than required by virgin polyester. The recycled material preserves the virgin oil needed to manufacture new fibers and is without limitation in its application.



CORK

Cork is extracted **without permanently harming the tree,** there are many hectares of cork in the world, which makes it an abundant resource that will regenerate far faster than humans can use it. Due to its softness and bounce-back, cork is good at slip resistant.



HEMP



Hemp is warm, breathable, pest-tolerant and easy to grow, producing much more fiber per square meter and **less water input than cotton**. Its rich and supple texture gives tremendous durability, strength and versatility.

VEGETAL TANNED LEATHER



Vegetal-tanned leather is non-allergenic and is made without the use of heavy metals found in chrome-tanned leather. Vegetal-tanned leather reduces water pollution and offers natural, earth tone colors that can then be dyed.

RECYCLED CORRUGATED SHIPPING BOXES



The Zabin Group is a manufacturer's representative for one of the world's largest provider of corrugated boxes. This allows our team to provide programs at competitive prices for all their distribution needs.





RECYCLED AND BIO PLASTICS

Polybags are typically used to protect a garment from damage during the shipping process. With discarded plastics a big cause of pollution by cluttering rivers, seas, and beaches, use of recycled plastic helps clean the environment and controls pollution. Utilizing 100 pounds of recycled or bio film rather than virgin petroleum based film saves about **14 gallons of gasoline**, eliminates **6 weeks worth of CO2** emissions from an automobile, or produces enough energy to power a **100-watt light bulb for 8 months**.

LOW WATER PLATING AND WATER RECYCLING





The majority of our plating finishes require **50% less water** to produce and our state of the art water recycling station allows us to recycle about **50%** of the water used in the plating process.



ENVIRONMENTALLY FRIENDLY INKS

During specific print processes we utilize **Water-based**, **Soy-based**, **and/or Vegetable-based** inks when possible. While these less "oily" inks take longer to dry, these inks make it easier to recycle the paper it is printed on. Additionally, the use of these inks can lower the emissions that cause air pollution.

SEEDED PAPER

We craft our seed paper from 100% post-industrial, recycled paper and dyed with all-natural, vegetable-based pigments. Our products are printed with water-based inks and are **100% biodegradable**. The paper can be formulated with wildflower, herb or vegetable seeds, and properly planted can grow into mature plants.





TREELESS PAPER

Approximately one out of every three trees harvested today ends up as pulp for paper products and unfortunately trees from old growth forests are still often felled to meet the demand. The Zabin Group offers our customer's **alternative paper options** produced from **sugar cane (bagasse), hemp, cotton (from textile waste), banana leaf, coffee, linen and yes, even elephant excrement.**

CHEMICAL AND MATERIAL MANAGEMENT

The Zabin Group's mission is to protect people and our environment by identifying and managing risks associated with the chemicals and fabrications used in the materials we choose and the production process we use in our factories. We strive to exceed the industry's top requirements and standards in reducing and removing harmful toxins from the products we manufacture.

The Zabin Group provides Oeko Tex & ISO-certified, supply chain certification, RSL / SGS tested & certified material management tracking, global recycling standards certification, in addition to all our products complying with the Consumer Product Safety Improvement Act (CPSIA). CPSIA regulations were established in 2008 to reduce the exposure of toxins such as lead and phthalates on products such as snaps and other metal closures that are used for children's clothing. Additionally, we monitor other toxins on packaging we produce, such as lead, cadmium, hexavalent chromium and mercury due to strict requirements for the products we ship to our European customers.

We also employ the use of a XRF analyzer. This analytical technique is used to determine the elemental composition of materials in products such as metal closures and eyelets. The XRF analyzer is also able to test compliancy in our Heat Transfer products as well.

The Zabin Group is committed to reducing our global footprint throughout our network of facilities around the world. We are currently ahead of our goal to have all our facilities environmentally certified under ISO14001. Our recycled and sustainable products are certifiable through SGS and the Global recycle standards.
