Customs Compliance | One PLM Requirements - Apparel

- **Communication** Provide details as soon as possible (prefer 60 days prior to first XF) via onePLM.
- **Detail** onePLM must include the following detail:
 - Material content be specific. If multiple fabrications within the same product, please list all positions
 - Construction knit, woven, etc
 - Stitch Counts for upper body garments (Knits)
 - Per 1 cm vertical and horizontal: 2CM for sweaters
 - Clear photos are mandatory. Samples provided upon request
 - Brief description if more than one product within the style, advise
 - Country of Production
 - First Cost
 - POM
- Changes If any changes occur to the product, such as material content, style, etc., communicate ASAP
- onePLM Brokers Description section should be used to describe apparel commodity on the commercial invoice
- Classification and Duty Review
 - Any additional information needed will be requested via email
 - When the review is completed, the style will be classified in onePLM
 - If a Customs Binding Ruling is needed, a production sample is required. (~30 days)
 - Communication will be sent to Broker for entry.
