Hello Mill Partners.

Bulk quality and handfeel approvals have been previously managed by our Li & Fung Merchandising Team. As Kohl's transitions to a direct to vendor model there is a need to establish a process for setting fabric standards and approval authority with the intention to shift bulk quality approval ownership to the vendors.

This process will begin with a pilot for Summer 2025 development season and roll out for Fall 2025 development season for the below vendors. Additional vendors will be added to the pilot and certification in upcoming seasons.

Mill Expectations:

- Material Confirmation Form (MCF) is submitted to design in the development stage, mill should have a min 5-10yds available
- MCF is approved by design as standard, Vendor will reach out to the mill for the MCF.
- At any given point the mill should have an additional copy of the MCF, so that communication flows between Vendor, Mill and Kohls.

Please find the Pilot and the Certification process with the timeline attached. This was shared with all the Wave 1 Vendors already.





To recap

Wave1 Pilot will start in the Summer 2025 development season.

Certification will be done in Fall 2025 for wave 1 pilot vendors.

Additional vendors will be added to the pilot and certification in upcoming seasons.
