

To avoid any confusion, please request vendor(s) to identify parts of this type of key chain as Custom's identifies them (see above image).

Customs requires each part to be identified as to specific material content:

- State each type of metal that comprises the entire article (if metal is composed of more than one metal, identify each precise metal by name (i.e. iron, steel, copper, aluminum, magnesium, etc.) of the decorative fob, the snap hook, the split wire ring, the connector loops, etc.
- Provide a breakdown in percentages by weight for each type of metal included in the above components/parts that comprise the entire article.

Per Customs, classification is based on predominate material. As per Section XV, Note 5(a) of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States (HTSUS), "An alloy of base metals is to be classified as an alloy of the metal which predominates by weight over each of the other metals."
