## **POM Naming Convention**





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# The POM naming convention process is broken into sections with Required or NOT Required information in each section

\*Section 1 = Size - Required - for below product categories

Size must be given with the size indicator within the style number, or the size range spelled out.

Women's – R, E or P (Regular, Petite or Plus)

Men's – R, B or T (Regular, Big or Tall)

Children's – 12M, 3T or 6

**EXAMPLE: R.**POPLIN.DOBBY.PLAIN WEAVE

#### \*Section 2 = Additional size or set break down – Required only if used in your category-

If a separate POM page is used for a type of fit, the fit type must be identified in the POM name.

Curvy or straight fits – C, S

EXAMPLE: R.C. PPLN. DBBY. PLN WV. SAE A

If you have multiple pieces/sets in one tech pack, each POM page should be identified.

2 pc sets – indicate a TOP or BTM

**EXAMPLE:** R.TOP.PPLN.DBBY.PLN WV.SAE A

#### **POM Naming Convention**

\*Section 3 = Generic Fabric Construction - Required -

EXAMPLE: Single Fabric - R.C.TWLL.SAE A

EXAMPLE: Multi Fabric - R.C.PPLN.DBBY.PLN WV.SAE A

\*Section 4 = Additional Descriptor(s); Vendor, Fabric Content, Print, Solid, Wash – NOT Required -

Use to further identify POM pages in tech packs....

VENDOR EXAMPLE: R.C.POPLIN.DOBBY.PLAIN WEAVE.SAE A

R.TOP.POPLIN.DOBBY.PLAIN WEAVE.HANSOLL

FINISH EXAMPLE: R.TOP.JERSEY.SOLID

R.TOP.JERSEY. DIP DYE

**CONTENT EXAMPLE:** R.TOP.JERSEY.**50/50 CTTN/PLY** 

R.TOP.JERSEY.50/38/12 CTTN/PLY/RYN

**SWEATERS EXAMPLE:** R.3GG.JERSEY (Size.Gauge.Stitch)
