# **Vendor Hard Home Classification Requirements**

- 1. Full material content required in OnePLM, use the Vendor Classification Notes field, adding to 100%. For example: 60% Aluminum/40% Stainless Steel. If mixed media material content, please indicate its position/location on the product ex. 60% stoneware ceramic vase/40% plastic floral
- 2. Clear Pictures of every product is required
- 3. The offerline MUST be placed in Ready to Preclass status after ALL of the required information (pictures and content) is listed in OnePLM, not before
- 4. If there is a Set please provide ALL content (added 100%) and clear pictures for ALL items within the set
- 5. The required information must be completely filled out in OnePLM at least 6 weeks prior to ex-factory

## **ALL PRODUCTS**

**Wood and Natural materials** (wood, MDF, plywood, rattan, dried leaves or flowers, pinecones, seed pods, etc.)

- Provide the Common name, Scientific name (Genus & Species),
  Country of Origin, and Quantity in kilograms or square meters only
- Provide the Toxic Substance Control Act Certification (TSCA)
- Provide the Plant and Plant Product Declaration (form: PPQ 505)

# Animal materials (Feathers, Shells, Hair, etc.)

 Provide Common name, Scientific name (Genus & Species), Country of Origin, Source (farm raised, wild, etc.), and Quantity in kilograms or square meters only

What is the type of Ceramic? (porcelain, china, earthenware, etc.)

# **FOOD PREP**

Is the timer Digital or Analog? Does it have a Jewel movement?

## **DINNERWARE**

Is it a set? What are the pieces included and number of pieces? What is the cost breakdown? What are the dimensions for each piece?

## **CUTLERY SETS**

- Indicate what products are within the whole set, the number of pieces within the set and provide cost breakdown & dimensions for each piece.
- If stainless steel, is there Nickel or Manganese? What is the percentage?
- What is the material content of the handle?

# **COOKWARE POTS AND PANS**

What metal is it made of? Steel, Stainless Steel, etc. If cast iron, is it enameled?

## **HOLIDAY DECOR AND DECOR**

Resin vs Polyresin: What is the percentage of calcium carbonate? Potpourri: Is it scented or unscented?
