GARMENT DETAILS Arrangement & Styling





For Counter, Fit, and 3D Final samples, reference the following for cropping guidance. For garment types that aren't listed below, show the full garment and crop with some cushion of space at sides.

Tops: Crop at top of neck stump, edge of arms, near mid thigh so length of top can be seen. Leave a small cushion of space around edge of crop.

Bottoms: Crop at mid belly, edge of leg stumps. Leave a small cushion of space around edge of crop. **Full Body Garments:** Crop at top of neck stump, edge of leg stumps. Leave a small cushion of space around edge of crop.












APPENDIX C Substitution Guidance for Digital Materials

If you must substitute a fabric follow the guidelines below:

- 1. Material Type/Construction: must be identical (ex: knit, woven)
- 2. Material Sub Type: must be identical (ex: jersey, french terry, mesh, twill, rib)
- 3. **Fabric Weight:** +/- 3% of the actual fabrics' contracted weight
- 4. **Fabric Thickness:** +/- 3%
- 5. Fiber Content: (See table below)

1 fiber (ex: 100% CTN)	NO TOLERANCE		
2+ fibers (ex: 60% CTN, 40% POLY)	+/- 3%		
Spandex Content	NO TOLERANCE		

Note, the final decision on selected substitute fabric belongs to the Kohl's Designer & Kohl's Material R&D Team, which decide on a fabric regardless of its compliance on the above guidelines.






